The State of Michigan passed a new law, Act 222 of Public Acts of 2001, which clarifies the conditions under which municipalities are liable for sewer backups. The Act sets standards to determine the extent to which a municipality is liable for backups and establishes a process that affected persons must follow to seek compensation when a backup occurs. In order to make a claim for damages or physical injury arising from a sewage disposal or storm water system event, all claimants must provide the following information:

Failure to provide proper notice will bar your claim.
